### Town Square Update - Past, Present & Future

**Past** - The Town Square is a Municipal Project that is supported by the BIA and was funded in part by a Canada 150 grant. Started in the fall of 2017, the project's construction cost of \$241,000 included catch basins, electrical connections, a locally constructed shade shelter, trees and other plant materials.

**Present** - The construction is complete! Did you know? The concrete represents the waterway and the seat walls represent the bridges. The armoured stone was reused from the original Corner Lot.

**Future** - Additions to the Town Square will include seating and interpretive signage. The new venue will be available for events; community groups are encouraged to come up with new ways to use the space. Don't forget that Santa will be in Town Square following the parade on November 24!
